PERMIT AGREEMENT AND CONDITIONS

As the applicant or operator of a motorized Golf Cart, ATV, or UTV, I agree to the following and understand that violation of the conditions of this permit or any city or state law, rule, or code may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit or other legal action.

1. I understand the permit allows for use of an all-terrain vehicle on designated streets within the City of Tyler. Designated roadways are all public streets under City jurisdiction with speed limits of 30 miles per hour or less.
2. Every operator shall have proof of insurance in possession while operating the all-terrain vehicle on designated streets and shall produce such proof of insurance on demand of a police officer as specified in MN Statute 169.791.
3. The operation of all-terrain vehicles is expressly prohibited on all public boulevards, bike trails, walking trails, and sidewalks.
4. Off-road vehicles may only be operated on the designated roadways from sunrise to sunset. They shall not be operated during inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog, or other conditions, or at any time when there is insufficient light to clearly see persons and vehicles on the roadway at a distance of 500 feet.
5. The operation of an all-terrain vehicle shall not operate the vehicle in a manner as to annoy or disturb the general welfare of the public.
6. The operation of an all-terrain vehicle shall not be done in a careless, reckless, or negligent manner, to endanger the person or property of another or to cause injury or damage to another.
7. All-terrain vehicles shall not operate while towing a sled, toboggan, wagon, trailer or other object unless such sled, toboggan, wagon, trailer or other object is attached to the snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle by a solid hitch;
8. Golf carts must display the slow-moving emblem as described in Minnesota Statutes, Section 169.522 when operated on designated roadways.
9. Off-road vehicles must be equipped with a rear-view mirror.
10. A copy of this permit must be carried on the off-road vehicle at all times.
11. The permit decal must be displayed on the left front (driver's side) of the vehicle at all times.
12. I understand that the city of Tyler assumes NO LIABILITY for any injuries to persons or property which may result from my operation of an all-terrain vehicle.
13. Permits are effective for one calendar year beginning January 1st and ending December 31st.
14. I understand and agree to follow all MN traffic laws and the conditions set forth in city code section 6.

* All-Terrain Vehicles are regulated by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources. Before operating an all-terrain vehicle, all operators must have proper licensure or certification and must have current registration on the vehicle. In addition, all-terrain vehicles including motorized golf carts, all-terrain vehicles (ATV), and utility task vehicles (UTV) are regulated by Tyler city code section 6.
