

**Tyler City Council
Special Planning Session
Monday, March 20, 2017
Tyler Fire Hall
7 p.m. (Approved)**

Members present, Mayor Greg Peter, Council members Tim Sanderson, Erick Harper, Scott Dressen and Kenneth Jensen and City administrator Robert Wolfington. Also present Tim O’Leary and Dave Haroldson.

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m.

Agenda – Motion by Tim Sanderson to approve the agenda. Kenneth Jensen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Lyon-Lincoln Electric – Tim O’Leary of Lyon-Lincoln Electric provided information on the agreement the City of Tyler has with Lyon-Lincoln Electric to provide lineman services. O’Leary answered questions about mutual aid, amount of time LLE services the Tyler system and what parts of the system should be addressed.

Priority List – City Administrator Wolfington provided the council with the area in Tyler that would be worked on in the 2017 portion of the Street Project. Wolfington stated the council would consider advertising for the work to be done during the next regular council meeting.

Goals and Objectives – The City Council reviewed a number of things it considered goals and objectives:

Reviewing the gas and water bonds, concern over blight issues, the water system in the Browerville development, the gravel roads in Tyler needing attention, the garbage truck replacement plan, housing and partnership with TRED, semi-truck parking availability, sidewalks.

Administrator Wolfington will work on gathering information on these subjects for a future planning session to determine a priority list.
