

**Resolution No. 2020-06**

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING MARKED CROSSWALKS  
AT STATE HIGHWAY 14 AND TYLER STREET (AND KAYE STREET, WILLOW STREET) AND RRFB DEVICES AT  
STATE HIGHWAY 14 AND KAYE STREET (AND/OR TYLER STREET)**

WHEREAS, the City wishes to install new crosswalks at the intersections of State Highway 14 and Tyler Street (AND Kaye Street, AND Willow Street); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to add RRFB devices at the intersections of State Highway 14 and Kaye Street (AND/OR Tyler Street); and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the intersections of State Highway 14 and Tyler Street (AND Kaye Street, AND Willow Street) as locations with high pedestrian traffic and destination connectivity to the school, hospital, and downtown business district; and

WHEREAS, the City's Safe Walkable Community Task Force through SRTS and Active Living Planning has identified the need to install RRFB devices to provide safer crossings at the intersections of State Highway 14 and Kaye Street (AND Tyler Street); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accommodate safe crossings of State Highway 14; and

WHEREAS, the City is formally requesting that MnDOT approve the new crossings at the intersections of State Highway 14 and Tyler Street (AND Kaye Street, AND Willow Street) and;

WHEREAS, the City is formally requesting that MnDOT approve a RRFB device at the intersection of State Highway 14 and Kaye Street (AND/OR Tyler Street); and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that the City will be responsible for the crosswalk markings, painting and signing no parking minimum of 20' either side of crossing, installation of any enhanced pedestrian safety devices (and a maintenance agreement), and ongoing maintenance of the markings; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that MnDOT will install and maintain signage at approved crossing locations; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that if the City fails to maintain the crosswalks markings or RRFB devices MnDOT holds the right to remove all crosswalk signage; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TYLER that this formal request be made to MnDOT.
