RESOLUTION APPROVING 13D.021 DETERMINATIONS

WHEREAS, Joan Jagt, the Mayor of the City of Tyler has found that the following situation (the "Situation") exists:

Peace Time Emergency Due to COVID 19 Health Pandemic

WHEREAS, the Governor has issued Executive Order 20-01 declaring a peace time emergency and coordinating Minnesota's Strategy to Protect Minnesotans from COVID-19 (attached); and

WHEREAS, Mayor Jagt has declared that an in-person meeting or a meeting conducted under section 13D.02 is not practical or prudent because of the health pandemic or emergency declared under Chapter 12; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Tyler agrees with Mayor Jagt's determinations;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tyler, Minnesota, as follows:

The city council finds that because of the health pandemic and emergency declaration, the city council approves the determination that attendance at the regular meeting location by members of the public is not feasible.


"This declaration of a local emergency will invoke the powers of the city as authorized under Lincoln County's Emergency Response plan".

The City Administrator and other Emergency Officials, and their designees, are authorized to take other appropriate emergency actions directed or recommended by federal and state government or health organizations, or deemed necessary by City emergency management authorities, including those otherwise inconsistent with established laws, policies and procedures, as determined to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
