

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-17**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Minnesota Legislature requires the adoption of a proposed levy on or before September 30, 2021, and a final tax levy prior to December 28, 2021, and

**WHEREAS**, the City passed a preliminary levy on September 7, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the City did hold a levy and budget public input meeting at 6:00 P.M. on December 6, 2021 prior to the adoption of the final tax levy and budget, and


**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Tyler City Council to adopt a final levy and final budget for 2022.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the final budget for the General Fund of the City of Tyler shall provide for revenues of \$1,357,303 and expenditures of \$1,357,303 of which the revenues will be supported with a tax levy of \$385,483; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the special budgets, revenues and expenditures, be hereby adopted with total City revenues for 2022 totaling \$2,662,524 for all other funds and expenditures for 2021 totaling \$2,662,524 for all other funds.
